

TRUCK HEAVY MC3 (MACK) - ALL TYPES
FITTING OF HEADLIGHT PROTECTORS

MODIFICATION INSTRUCTION

Introduction

1. This instruction details the fitting of clear plastic headlight protectors to reduce the instances of cracked or broken headlight lenses on the subject vehicles.

Note:

1. NSN and Designation used in this instruction were current at the date of issue. If twelve months or more have expired since issue, the NSN should be checked for supersession.

General

2. Estimated Manhours to Perform. 0.1 (initial planning only).
3. Priority. Group 2. All vehicles are to be modified when next in workshops for servicing/repairs.
4. Modification to be Applied to. All subject vehicles.
5. Action Required. By RAEME units authorised to carry out unit, field and base repairs, in accordance with WKSP A 850.

6. Stores to be Removed. Nil.

Detail

7. To carry out the modification proceed as follows:
 - a. Drill a 3mm hole centrally in base section of each headlight protector.
 - b. Remove headlight rim.
 - c. Fit headlight protector over headlight (hole to bottom).
 - d. Refit headlight rim and tighten.

Modification Record Plate

8. The modification is to be recorded as follows:
- a. Truck Cargo/Truck Cargo Winch Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 12.
 - b. Truck Cargo Crane Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 13.
 - c. Truck Ammunition/Truck Gun Tractor Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 12.
 - d. Truck Dump/Truck Dump Winch Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 9.
 - e. Truck Tank Fuel/Truck Tank Water Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 8.
 - f. Truck Bitumen Distributor Heavy MC4 (Mack) deface the numeral 4.
 - g. Truck Transit Mixer Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 5.
 - h. Truck Wrecker Heavy MC3 (Mack) deface the numeral 5.

Documentation

9. Details of the modification are to be entered in the TGM 120 Record Book for Service Equipment.
